

Sakarya University Industrial Engineering (IE) Department has been providing education since 1977. 5 Professors, 3 Associate Professors, 19 Assistant Professors, and 11 Research Assistants serve. IE department has graduated approximately 3950 industrial engineers until today. The alumni work in a wide variety of manufacturing and service areas.

IE Department provides student-oriented and practice-oriented education. The objective is to give students the ability to use the essential technical and advanced tools to solve the problems in manufacturing and services areas. Teaching subjects are Operation Research, Manufacturing Planning, Quality Management, Artificial Intelligence/Expert Systems, Engineering Economics, Project management, Logistics and Supply Chain, Facility Planning and Design Simulation Decision Sciences and more.

The education language is Turkish, but students can optionally take some courses in English.



There are two laboratories, Computer Integrated Manufacturing and Work Study & Ergonomics Laboratory in the department.



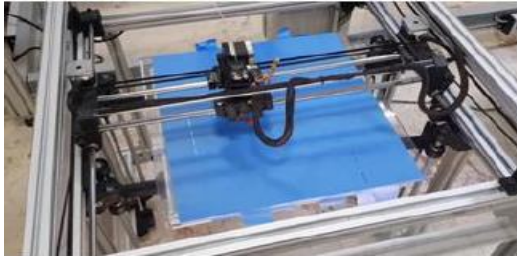

In order to enable our students to apply what they have learned, they have to do two internships, the first of which is the Workshop and the second is Production and Management.

There is also an optional Applied Engineering Experience Education (UMDE) Program for students. In the UMDE program, students work as a candidate engineer for one semester in the 4th Year Fall or Spring Semester by realizing projects in companies in various sectors to gain work experience and prepare for business life before graduation. Participation in UMDE Program increases our students' opportunities to find jobs in companies.

IE Department students can complete one more department at the same time thanks to the Double Major Program.

The students can take courses at universities and do their internships in many European countries within the scope of the ERASMUS program.

IE department has both Turkish and English Industrial Engineering graduate programs and Turkish doctoral programs. The department also has an Engineering Management graduate program, which also has a distance learning program option.

IE department organizes the International Intelligent Manufacturing System Symposium, which is repeated every two years, and also has hosted many national and international symposiums.



Industrial Engineering Student Club (SAUEMK) is one of the five most active clubs of Sakarya University and also one of the most active among Industrial Engineering clubs in Turkey.



Sakarya city distance to Istanbul, the largest city in Turkey, is only 140 km.

Sakarya is an industrial city. The international and national companies are producing cars, electronic parts, wagons, tanks, military vehicles, trucks, textile products, food products, buses in Sakarya. This gives the students the advantage of experiencing many different sectors.

Sakarya has a coast on the Black Sea, and Sapanca lake, and Sakarya river. IE Department is located in the Sakarya University Esentepe Campus by the Sapanca lake. The students have the opportunity to do water sports in Sapanca lake, and also to do winter sports in the Kartepe ski center, which is only 27 km away from the campus during the winter months.
